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Dear Parent or Guardian,

Based on the recommendation by the CDC that all children under the age of 10 receive two doses of H1N1 vaccine, LaSalle County Health Department will be returning to your child's school on **Thursday, January 28** to provide a booster dose (second dose) to your child. All children under the age of 10 are advised and recommended to have a second dose of H1N1 vaccine to provide the best immunity/protection against H1N1. Adults and children ages 10 and older do not require a second dose.

If you are the parent or guardian of a child who missed the first school based clinic, your child can receive an H1N1 vaccine at this clinic. If they are under the age of 10, you will need to follow-up with LaSalle County Health Department for a second dose as we will not be returning to school for any further clinics.

Please send the H1N1 Vaccination record (a yellow folded card) your child received at the first school based clinic along with the signed consent form to the school. The card will be updated with the second dose and returned to your child after the school clinic.
